### **RESEARCH AT DOMS**

#### 1. What are the research areas in DoMS?

#### 2. What are the different categories of admission at DoMS?

The different categories of admission are:

- Full Time MS HTRA (Half Time Research Assistance) / Non HTRA
- · Full Time PhD HTRA / UGC JRF / Non HTRA
- · Direct PhD
- · Part-Time PhD
- External PhD

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

#### 1. When does the admission happen for research programs?

You can apply any time of the year but admissions happen twice a year: Once for semester starting July (odd semester) and a second time for another starting January (even semester). Application deadlines are typically sometime in March and October for odd and even semesters respectively. Please visit IITM website for exact deadlines for any given year. The interview dates for candidates are tentatively sometime in April for odd semester and sometime in November for even semester at DoMS. Candidates should refer to their call letters for the exact date and time of the interview. #### 2. What are the eligibility criteria for MS and PhD programs?

#### 3. What are the eligibility criteria for part-time/external PhD programs?

#### 4. What is the selection process for admission at DOMS?

The candidate's application along with the SOP (Statement of Purpose) and Research Proposal are scrutinized. Eligible candidates are called to the institute for document verification followed by a written test (in some cases) and personal interview. Details of the selection process will be shared with the shortlisted candidates via email.

#### 5. Can executives/working professionals pursue part-time PhD at DoMS?

Yes. DoMS offers part-time PhD programme for executives/working professionals. However, they have to complete the mandatory course work by attending classes in the campus which may take somewhere between 6 months to 1 year.

# 6. I am applying for a part time scholar category. Am I allowed to stay in a different city while pursuing research?

You can. However, you have to complete the mandatory course work by attending classes in the campus which may take somewhere between 6 months to 1 year.

# 7. I have completed my post-graduation in a discipline that is unrelated to the area of specialization that I am applying for. Am I still eligible to apply for a PhD program in that area?

You may apply. However, the decision to shortlist or select the application rests entirely at the discretion of the respective functional area.

# 8. I have done a one-year MBA programme. Am I eligible to apply for an MS or PhD program?

**No**, candidates with a one-year MBA programme are NOT eligible to apply for a research program.

# 9. I am working in a private firm in a foreign country. Am I eligible for a part time PhD category?

No, Foreign nationals can only register as full-time scholars.

### **QUALIFYING EXAMS**

# 1. What are the qualifying exams that are accepted for the HTRA category in the PhD program?

To be eligible for the HTRA fellowship, candidates are required to have a valid CAT / GATE / UGC-NET / CSIR- NET score.

Candidates with valid GMAT / GRE scores or with relevant work experience can apply under the Non-HTRA category and they will not be eligible for the fellowship.

# 2. What are the qualifying exams that are accepted for the HTRA category in MS program?

To be eligible for the HTRA fellowship, candidates are required to have a valid GATE score.

Candidates with relevant work experience can apply under the Non-HTRA category and will not be eligible for the fellowship.

# 3. I am planning to apply for the part-time / external scholar category. Do I need to have a qualifying exam score?

PhD applicants with <u>at least 5 years of Managerial Experience</u> and MS applicants having <u>at least 3 years of Managerial Experience</u> are exempted from these examinations.

### SHORTLISTING FOR INTERVIEW

#### 1. What will be the procedure for shortlisting the applications?

The applications will be shortlisted based on:

- Academic credentials,
- Qualifying Exam Scores,
- Research Proposals and Statement of Purpose

□ MS Candidates are required to submit a Statement of Purpose with a broad outline of the research topic/area/ questions. Research Proposal is <u>not mandatory</u> <u>for MS candidates</u>, but is encouraged and will add value to your application.

PhD candidates are **mandatorily required** to submit a Research Proposal.

#### 2. What is expected out of my Statement of Purpose?

The statement of purpose should include the *purpose* for which the candidate is applying to the research program of Department of Management studies, IIT-Madras. Broadly, it should convey *why the candidate has chosen the area of specialization* and *what she/he intends to do during their tenure* at DoMS, if selected for the program. It should also provide a *broad outline of the research topic/ area/ research questions* the candidate is interested to pursue. It can also include any *relevant experience* that the candidate has, their understanding about the nature of the program and what they would be able to contribute to the department and institute, if selected.

# 3. What is a Research Proposal and what is expected out of my research proposal?

The research proposal (1500 words) should be the original work of the candidate and will be checked for plagiarism. It should convey what the candidate intends to do, if selected for the program. The proposal should be related to the area of specialization that the candidate is applying to. The following is the basic layout of the research proposal. However, it is not a strict design and the candidate is free to enhance it.

- Introduction Problem Identification / Problem Statement
- Brief Review of Literature May include Research Gaps, Research Questions, Objectives, Hypotheses
- Proposed Methodology May include samples, tools and techniques etc. if available
- Proposed Implications How the proposed study will further knowledge in the research area and management practice
- References/Bibliography

#### 4. Where can I check the Shortlist for the interview?

The Shortlist for interview along with the dates of interview be displayed on <u>https://doms.iitm.ac.in</u>. The shortlisted candidates will also be informed by email.

### **INTERVIEW & WRITTEN TEST**

#### 1. What are the documents that I need to bring on the day of the interview?

#### 2. What can I expect on the day of the interview?

The broad set of procedures may include document verification, a written test (which may be conducted for some functional areas and for those who have got their qualifying degrees before 10 years) and an interview. The procedure is subject to change at the discretion of the department.

#### 3. When can I expect the results of the process?

The final results can be expected in around a month's time following the interview. The selected candidates will be informed by e-mail and the list will be put up on the department website.

#### 4. Can I reapply for MS / PhD, if not shortlisted?

Yes, you can re-apply to the program in the next intakes/ semesters.

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

#### 1. What is the fee structure of the program?

#### 2. Is there a stipend/ scholarship provided for the MS / PhD program?

Stipend will be provided to students who are selected under the HTRA / UGC-JRF categories, subject to the performance of Half Time Research Assistantship duties. # 3. I have been selected under the part-time / external categories – Will I get a stipend?

No, Part-time and external category candidates will not receive a stipend.

#### 4. How long will it take to complete the course work?

Since the department norm requires candidates to do rigorous coursework, scholars are expected to complete the course work requirements. Though, technically, the course work could be completed in 6 months, due to the compulsory courses, which are not offered in all the quarters, it is safe to assume that it may take 1 year to complete all the course requirements.

#### 5. What is the minimum requirement for submission of thesis?

Before a candidate submits the MS / PhD thesis, it is expected that (s)he has at least two publications – one in good quality peer reviewed international journal and one in conference proceedings. This is only indicative. Scholars in the past have published more publications than the minimum required.

#### 6. Can I stay on campus during my MS / PhD program?

Yes. Accommodation in hostels is provided for full-time HTRA research scholars. Quarters are provided to married scholars, subject to availability.

#### 7. What is the duration of an MS/PhD program?

After the mandatory course work, the PhD scholars in the full-time category have taken nearly 3-4 years and MS scholars have taken 1 and half- 2 years on an average to submit the thesis. Candidates in other categories have taken a little longer.
