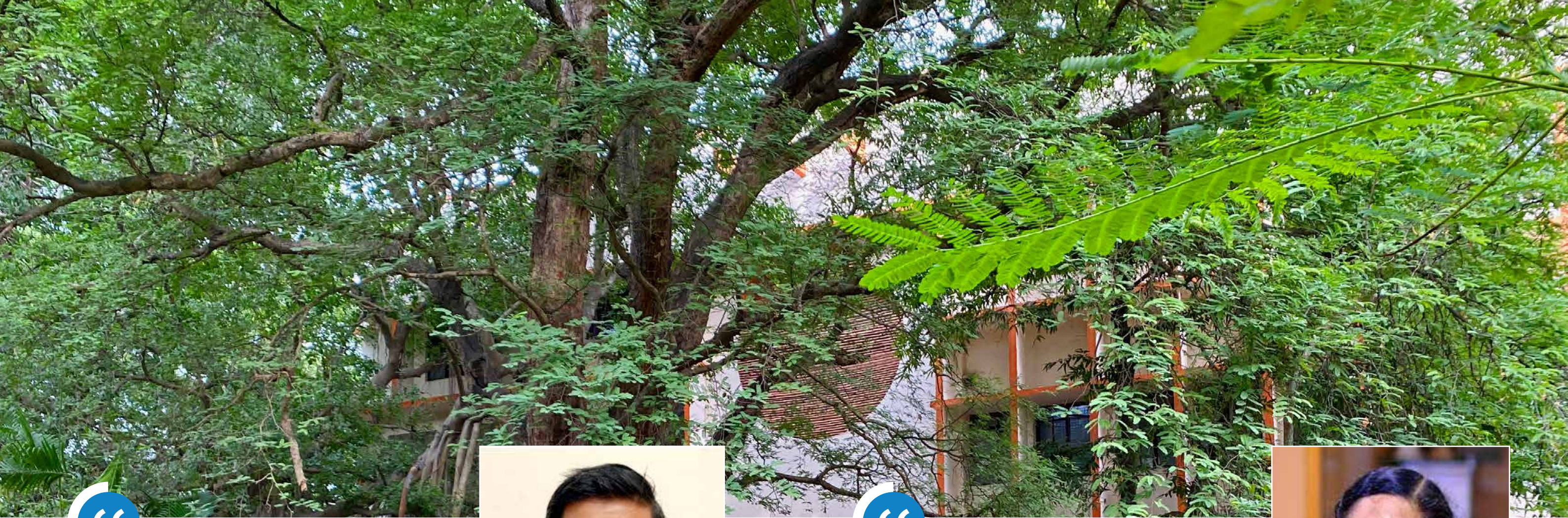

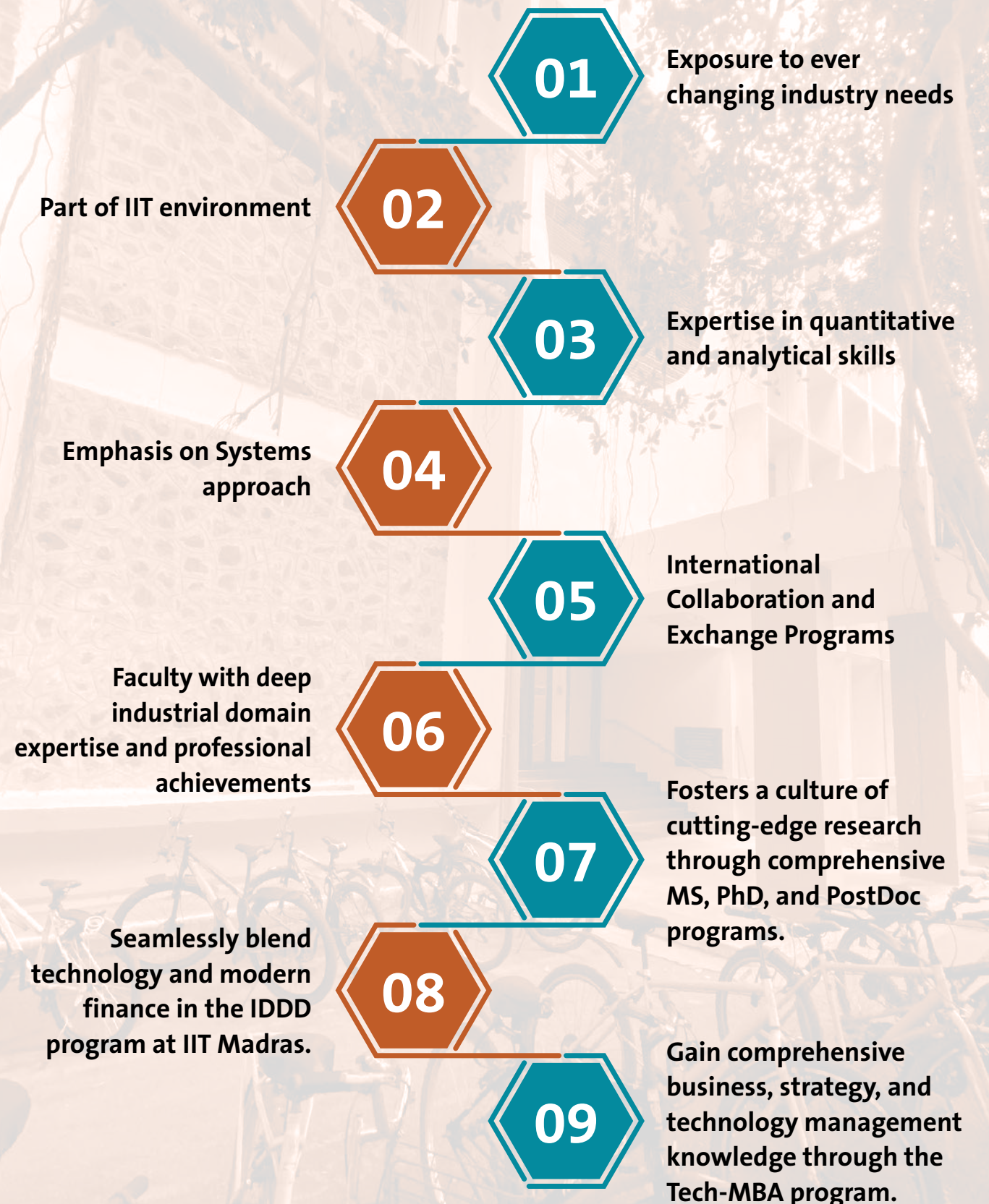

Background

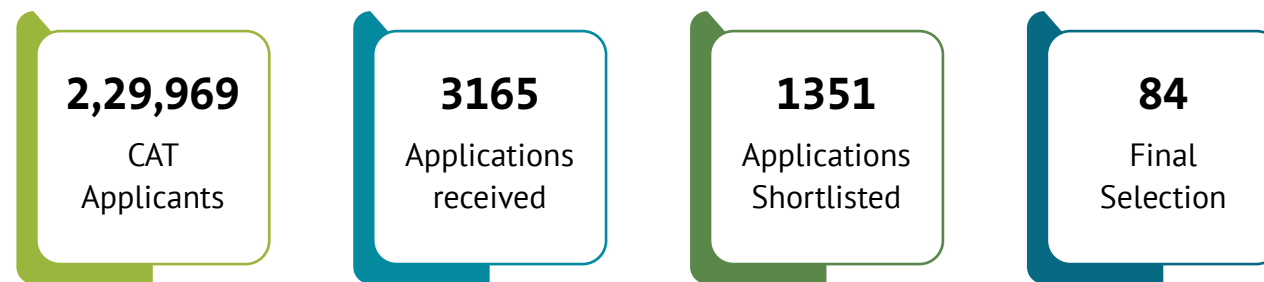

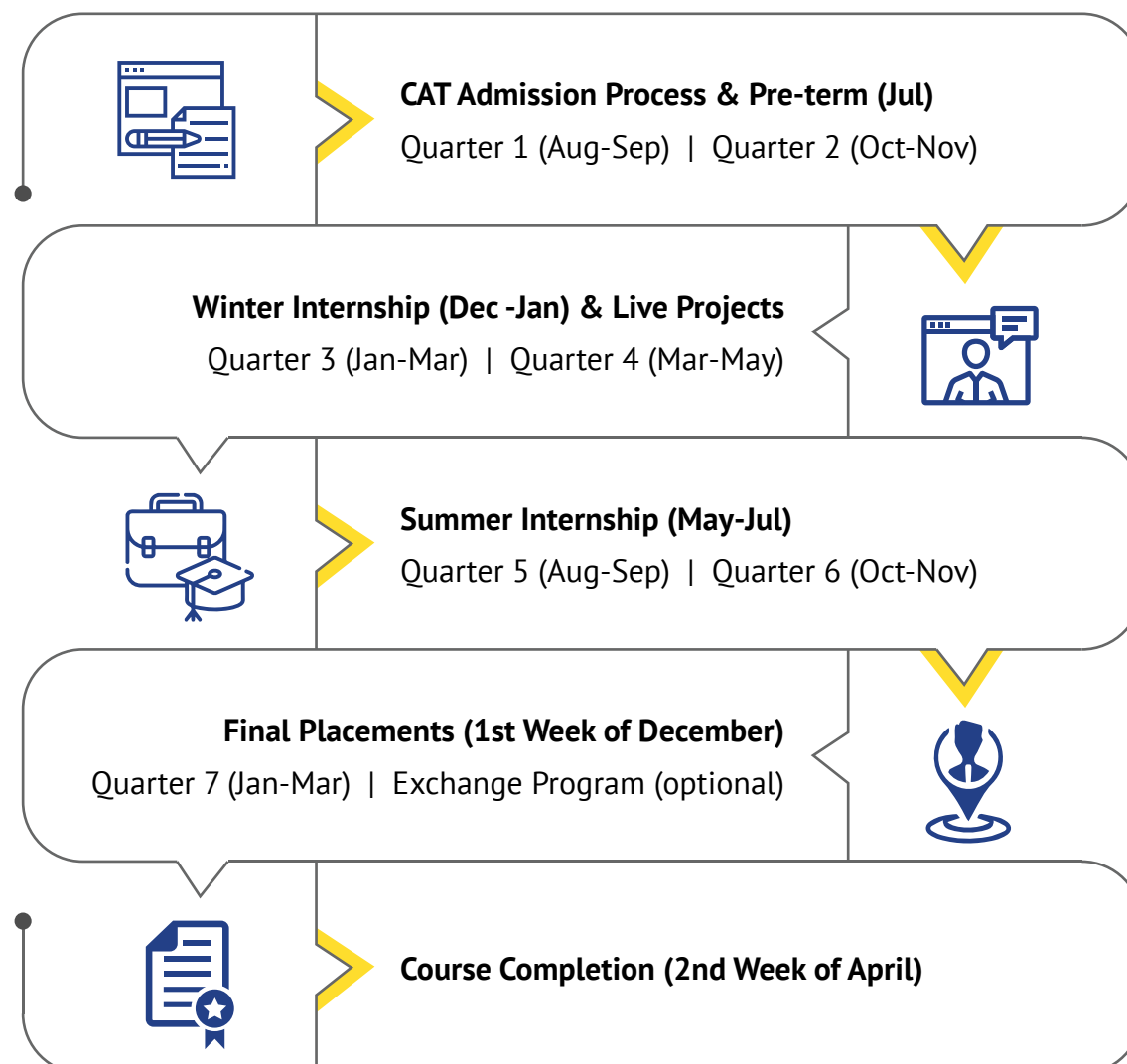

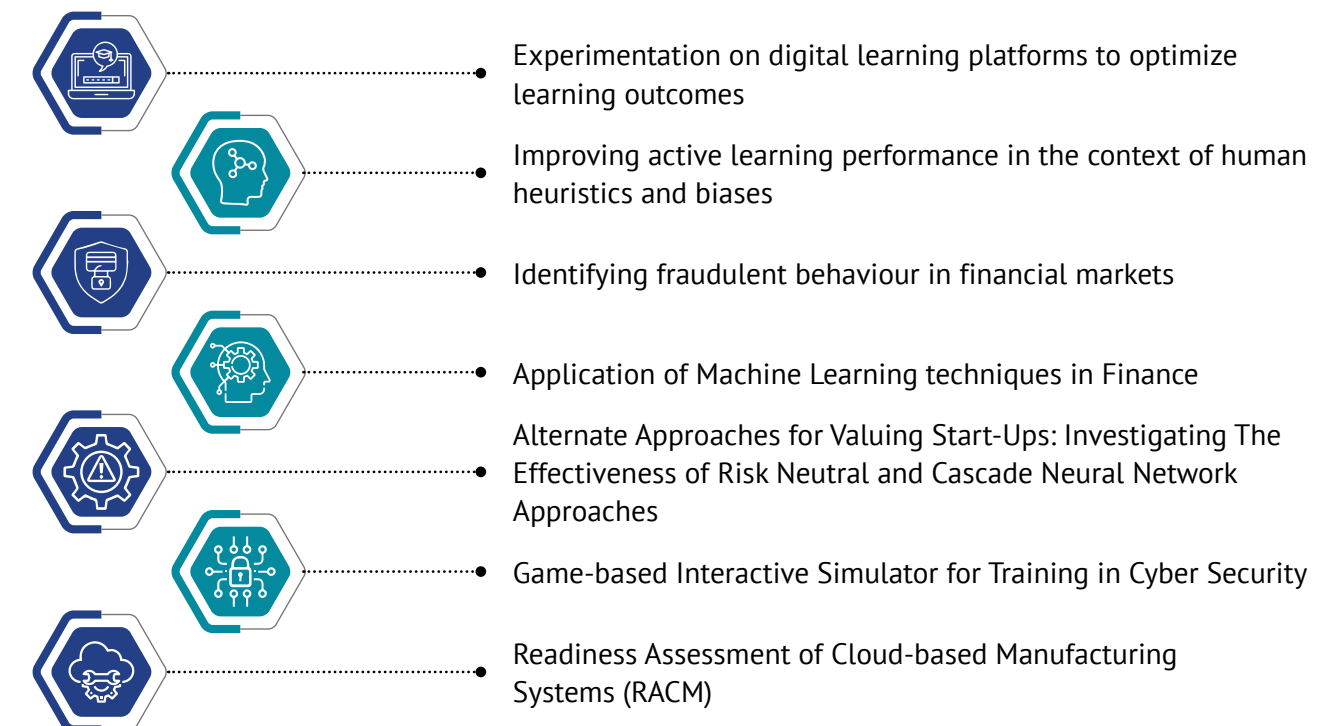
Department of Management Studies FACULTY

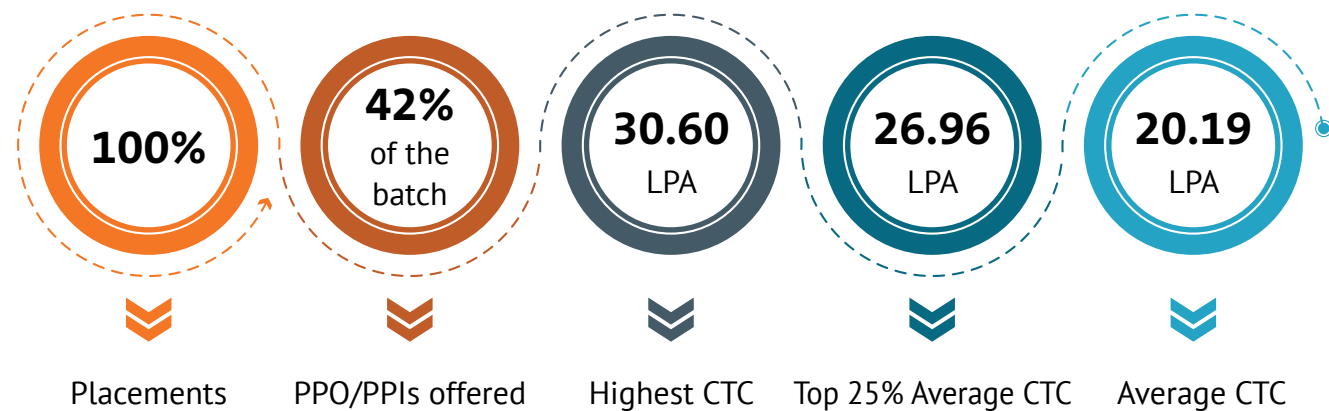

SUMMER INTERNSHIPS

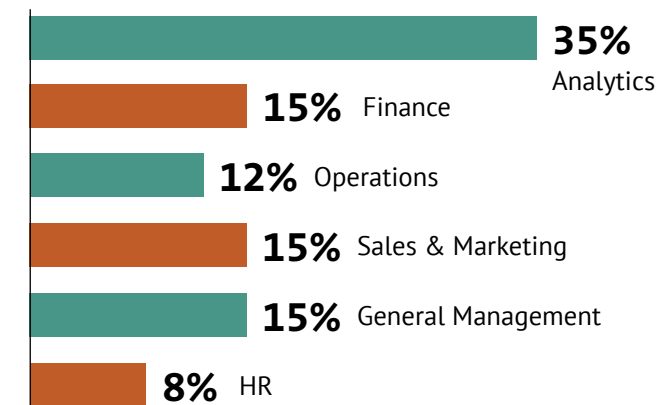
The summer internship program holds immense significance within the MBA program at DoMS, IIT Madras. Spanning over two months, this internship provides valuable industry exposure to all students, allowing them to apply the knowledge acquired during their first year of the MBA course. The exceptional performance of DoMS students has been repeatedly demonstrated, with many of them securing full-time job offers through Pre-Placement Offers (PPOs). The mandatory internship carries a weightage of one credit. Prior to the internship's commencement, companies assign groundwork to the students, ensuring they are well-prepared from the start. Throughout the internship, each individual is assigned a guide who provides continuous evaluation of their work and the attainment of objectives. Upon completion, students are required to submit a comprehensive report summarizing their internship experience, and grades are awarded accordingly.

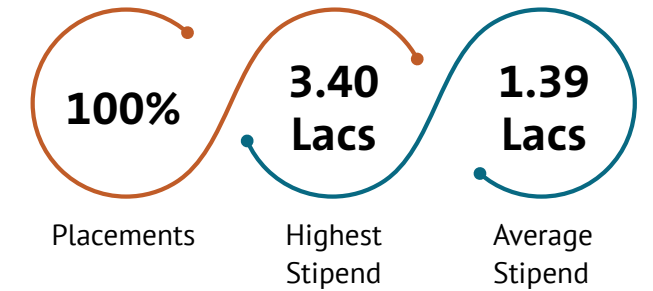

Among the list of new recruiters at DoMS, notable names such as P&G, Standard Chartered, Atria and Oracle stood out.

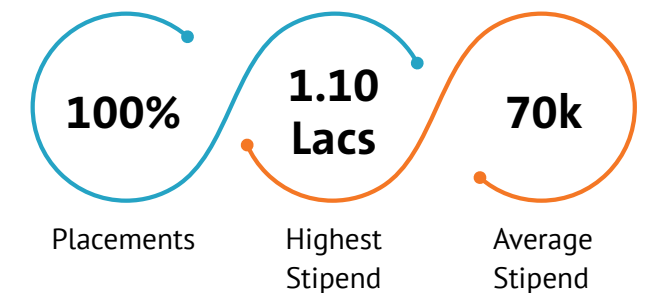
Domain Distribution
